When thou hast made an end of tithing all the tithes of thine increase the third year, which is the year of tithing, and hast given it unto the Levite, the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, that they may eat within thy gates, and be filled;

Deuteronomy 28:50

A nation of fierce countenance, which shall not regard the person of the old, nor shew favour to the young:

Deuteronomy 30:16

In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

Deuteronomy 32:46

And he said unto them, Set your hearts unto all the words which I testify among you this day, which ye shall command your children to observe to do, all the words of this law.

Deuteronomy 33:23

And of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with favour, and full with the blessing of the LORD: possess thou the west and the south

Deuteronomy 33:29

Happy art thou, O Israel: who is like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who is the sword of thy

excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.

Joshua 9:3

And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,

For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might destroy them utterly, and that they might have no favour, but that he might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses.

Ruth 4:4

And I thought to advertise thee, saying, Buy it before the inhabitants, and before the elders of my people. If thou wilt redeem it, redeem it: but if thou wilt not redeem it, then tell me, that I may know: for there is none to redeem it beside thee; and I am after thee. And he said, I will redeem it.

Ruth 4:6

And the kinsman said, I cannot redeem it for myself, lest I mar mine own inheritance: redeem thou my right to thyself; for I cannot redeem it.

Ruth 4:7

Now this was the manner in former time in Israel concerning redeeming and concerning changing, for to confirm all things; a man plucked off his shoe, and gave it to his neighbour: and this was a testimony in Israel.

1 Samuel 12:13

Now therefore behold the king whom ye have chosen, and whom ye have desired! and, behold, the LORD hath set a king over you.

1 Samuel 15:28

And Samuel said unto him, The LORD hath rent the kingdom of Israel from thee this day, and hath given it to a neighbour of thine, that is better than thou.

1 Samuel 16:22

And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight.

1 Samuel 22:23

Abide thou with me, fear not: for he that seeketh my life seeketh thy life: but with me thou shalt be in safeguard.

2 Samuel 3:8

Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ishbosheth, and said, Am I a dog's head, which against Judah do shew kindness this day unto the house of Saul thy father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered thee into the hand of David, that thou chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?

2 Samuel 7:23

And what one nation in the earth is like thy people, even like Israel, whom God went to redeem for a people to himself, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst to thee from Egypt, from the nations and their gods?

2 Samuel 19:9

And all the people were at strife throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, The king saved us out of the hand of our enemies, and he delivered us out of the hand of the Philistines; and now he is fled out of the land for Absalom.

2 Samuel 21:2

And the king called the Gibeonites, and said unto them; (now the Gibeonites were not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel had sworn unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal to the children of Israel and Judah.)

2 Samuel 22:4

I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.

2 Samuel 23:10

He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.

1 Kings 1:40

And all the people came up after him, and the people piped with pipes, and rejoiced with great joy, so that the earth rent with the sound of them.

1 Kings 3:5

In Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream by night: and God said, Ask what I shall give thee.

1 Kings 3:6

And Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day;

1 Kings 9:4

And if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, and wilt keep my statutes and my judgments:

1 Kings 10:1

And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions.

1 Kings 10:4

And when the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's wisdom, and the house that he had built,

1 Kings 10:10

And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices very great store, and precious stones: there came no more such abundance of spices as these which the queen of Sheba gave to king Solomon.

1 Kings 10:13

And king Solomon gave unto the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside that which Solomon gave her of his royal bounty. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.

1 Kings 11:19

And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

1 Kings 15:13

And also Maachah his mother, even her he removed from being queen, because she had made an idol in a grove; and Asa destroyed her idol, and burnt it by the brook Kidron.

1 Kings 16:34

In his days did Hiel the Bethelite build Jericho: he laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn, and set up the gates thereof in his youngest son Segub, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Joshua the son of Nun.

1 Kings 20:35

And a certain man of the sons of the prophets said unto his neighbour in the word of the LORD, Smite me, I pray thee. And the man refused to smite him.

2 Kings 10:13

Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who are ye? And they answered, We are the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

2 Kings 10:16

And he said, Come with me, and see my zeal for the LORD. So they made him ride in his chariot.

1 Chronicles 16:25

For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods.

1 Chronicles 16:29

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

1 Chronicles 28:9

And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

1 Chronicles 28:21

And, behold, the courses of the priests and the Levites, even they shall be with thee for all the service of the house of God: and there shall be with thee for all manner of workmanship every willing skilful man, for any manner of service: also the princes and all the people will be wholly at thy commandment.

1 Chronicles 29:1

Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, is yet young and tender, and the work is great: for the palace is not for man, but for the LORD God.

1 Chronicles 29:11

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.

1 Chronicles 29:17

I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with joy thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee.

2 Chronicles 6:6

But I have chosen Jerusalem, that my name might be there; and have chosen David to be over my people Israel.

2 Chronicles 9:1

And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon, she came to prove Solomon with hard questions at Jerusalem, with a very great company, and camels that bare spices, and gold in abundance, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

2 Chronicles 9:9

And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices great abundance, and precious stones: neither was there any such spice as the queen of Sheba gave king Solomon.

2 Chronicles 15:16

And also concerning Maachah the mother of Asa the king, he removed her from being queen, because she had made an idol in a grove: and Asa cut down her idol, and stamped it, and burnt it at the brook Kidron.

2 Chronicles 20:21

And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever.

2 Chronicles 31:18

And to the genealogy of all their little ones, their wives, and their sons, and their daughters, through all the congregation: for in their set office they sanctified themselves in holiness:

2 Chronicles 32:10

Thus saith Sennacherib king of Assyria, Whereon do ye trust, that ye abide in the siege in Jerusalem?

Nehemiah 1:5

And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments:

Nehemiah 2:6

And the king said unto me, (the queen also sitting by him,) For how long shall thy journey be? and when wilt thou return? So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time.

Nehemiah 3:2

And next unto him builded the men of Jericho. And next to them builded Zaccur the son of Imri.

Nehemiah 5:5

Yet now our flesh is as the flesh of our brethren, our children as their children: and, lo, we bring into bondage our sons and our daughters to be servants, and some of our daughters are brought unto bondage already: neither is it in our power to redeem them; for other men have our lands and vineyards.

Nehemiah 8:17

And all the congregation of them that were come again out of the captivity made booths, and sat under the booths: for since the days of Jeshua the son of Nun unto that day had not the children of Israel done so. And there was very great gladness.

Nehemiah 9:17

And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou art a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

Nehemiah 10:38

And the priest the son of Aaron shall be with the Levites, when the Levites take tithes: and the Levites shall bring up the tithe of the tithes unto the house of our God, to the chambers, into the treasure house.

Nehemiah 12:44

And at that time were some appointed over the chambers for the treasures, for the offerings, for the firstfruits, and for the tithes, to gather into them out of the fields of the cities the portions of the law for the priests and Levites: for Judah rejoiced for the priests and for the Levites that waited.

Esther 1:4

When he showed the riches of his glorious kingdom and the honour of his excellent majesty many days ever an hundred and fourscore days.

Esther 1:11

To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to shew the people and the princes her beauty: for she was fair to look on.

Esther 2:9

And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, which were meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best place of the house of the women.

Esther 2:17

And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

Esther 4:4

So Esther's maids and her chamberlains came and told it her. Then was the queen exceedingly grieved; and she sent raiment to clothe Mordecai, and to take away his sackcloth from him: but he received it not.

Esther 8:5

And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing seem right before the king, and I be pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which are in all the king's provinces:

Esther 8:6

For how can I endure to see the evil that shall come unto my people? or how can I endure to see the destruction of my kindred?

Job 4:6

Is not this thy fear, thy confidence, thy hope, and the uprightness of thy ways?

Job 6:23

Or, Deliver me from the enemy's hand? or, Redeem me from the hand of the mighty?

Job 8:7

Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase.

Job 8:15

He shall lean upon his house, but it shall not stand: he shall hold it fast, but it shall not endure.

Job 10:12

Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit.

Job 12:4

I am as one mocked of his neighbour, who calleth upon God, and he answereth him: the just upright man is laughed to scorn.

Job 29:1

Moreover Job continued his parable, and said,

Job 29:18

Then I said, I shall die in my nest, and I shall multiply my days as the sand.

Job 33:3

My words shall be of the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.

Job 33:15

In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed;

Job 37:23

Touching the Almighty we cannot find him out: he is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice he will not afflict.

Job 39:9

Will the unicorn be willing to serve thee, or abide by thy crib?

Psalms 8:1

O Lord our Lord how excellent is thy name in all the earth who hast set thy glory above the heavens.

Psalms 9:7

But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment.

Psalms 9:8

And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

Psalms 12:2

They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak.

Psalms 21:5

His glory is great in thy salvation: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him.

Psalms 25:21

Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee.

Psalms 26:11

But as for me, I will walk in mine integrity: redeem me, and be merciful unto me.

Psalms 29:2

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

Psalms 30:5

For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

Psalms 31:21

Blessed be the LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city.

Psalms 36:7

How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of the wings.

Psalms 40:16

Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: let such as love thy salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified.

Psalms 47:8

God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.

Psalms 48:1

Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of his holiness.

Psalms 49:4

I will incline mine ear to a parable: I will open my dark saying upon the harp.

Psalms 49:15

But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah.

Psalms 60:6

God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.

Psalms 67:6

Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us.

Psalms 69:9

For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me.

Psalms 71:21

Thou shalt increase my greatness, and comfort me on every side.

Psalms 72:5

They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations.

Psalms 72:14

He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.

Psalms 72:17

His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed.

Psalms 73:20

As a dream when one awaketh; so, O Lord, when thou awakest, thou shalt despise their image.

Psalms 76:4

Thou art more glorious and excellent, than the mountains of prey.

Psalms 89:3

I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant,

Psalms 93:5

Thy testimonies are very sure: holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever.

Psalms 98:1

O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.

Psalms 102:12

But thou, O LORD, shalt endure for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations.

Psalms 102:14

For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof.

Psalms 106:8

Nevertheless he saved them for his name's sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known.

Psalms 107:37

And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase.

Psalms 107:43

Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the loving-kindness of the LORD.

Psalms 110:3

Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth.

Psalms 111:8

They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness.

Psalms 117:2

For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.

Psalms 119:7

I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous judgments.

Psalms 119:58

I intreated thy favour with my whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word.

Psalms 119:139

My zeal hath consumed me, because mine enemies have forgotten thy words.

Psalms 141:5

Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also shall be in their calamities.

Psalms 143:10

Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness.

Psalms 150:2

Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness

Proverbs 1:5

A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels:

Proverbs 7:21

With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.

Proverbs 11:9

An hypocrite with his mouth destroyeth his neighbour: but through knowledge shall the just be delivered.

Proverbs 14:2

He that walketh in his uprightness feareth the LORD: but he that is perverse in his ways despiseth him.

Proverbs 14:21

He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy is he.

Proverbs 19:6

Many will intreat the favour of the prince: and every man is a friend to him that giveth gifts.

Proverbs 23:26

My son, give me thine heart, and let thine eyes observe my ways.

Proverbs 26:7

The legs of the lame are not equal: so is a parable in the mouth of fools.

Proverbs 28:6

Better is the poor that walketh in his uprightness, than he that is perverse in his ways, though he be rich.

Therefore will I cast you out of this land into a land that ye know not, neither ye nor your fathers; and there shall ye serve other gods day and night; where I will not shew you favour.

The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with loving-kindness have I drawn thee.

Jeremiah 31:23

Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As yet they shall use this speech in the land of Judah and in the cities thereof, when I shall bring again their captivity; The LORD bless thee, O habitation of justice, and mountain of holiness.

Jeremiah 31: 34

And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Jeremiah 33:22

As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me.

Jeremiah 52:8

But the army of the Chaldeans pursued after the king, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho; and all his army was scattered from him.

Ezekiel 5:13

Thus shall mine anger be accomplished, and I will cause my fury to rest upon them, and I will be comforted: and they shall know that I the LORD have spoken it in my zeal, when I have accomplished my fury in them.

Ezekiel 17: 2

Son of man, put forth a riddle, and speak a parable unto the house of Israel;

Ezekiel 22:14

Can thine heart endure, or can thine hands be strong, in the days that I shall deal with thee? I the LORD have spoken it, and will do it.

Ezekiel 34:27

And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.

And I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bring fruit: and I will settle you after your old estates, and will do better unto you than at your beginnings: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Daniel 1:9

Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs.

Daniel 2:6

But if ye shew the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honour: therefore shew me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.

Daniel 2:31

Thou, O king savest, and behold a great image this great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee: and the form thereof was terrible.

At the same time my reason returned unto me; And for the glory of my kindness, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me and I was established in my kingdom and excellent majesty was added unto me.

Daniel 5:10

Now the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came into the banquet house: and the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:

For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind:
it hath no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the
strangers shall swallow it up.

Hosea 13:14

I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them
from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy
destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

Joel 2:13

And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the
LORD your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and
of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

Joel 2:22

Be not afraid, ye beasts of the field: for the pastures of the wilderness
do spring, for the tree beareth her fruit, the fig tree and the vine do
yield their strength.

Amos 4:2

The Lord GOD hath sworn by his holiness, that, lo, the days shall
come upon you, that he will take you away with hooks, and your
posterity with fishhooks.

Amos 4:4

Come to Bethel, and transgress; at Gilgal multiply transgression; and
bring your sacrifices every morning, and your tithes after three years:

Jonah 4:2

And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was
not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled
before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and
merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of
the evil.

Habakkuk 2:6

Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth that which is not his! how long? and to him that ladeth himself with thick clay!

Malachi 3:8

Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

Malachi 3:10

Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

Matthew 1:19

Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily.

Matthew 2:12

And being warned of God in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed into their own country another way.

Matthew 3:16

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

Matthew 5:12

Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

Matthew 10:11

And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter, enquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till ye go thence.

Matthew 12:20

A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.

Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field:

Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Matthew 19:25

When his disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved?

Matthew 20:22

But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

Matthew 20:26

But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister;

Matthew 20:29

And as they departed from Jericho, a great multitude followed him.

Matthew 22:36

Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

Matthew 24:13

But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Matthew 28:20

Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world.
Amen.

Mark 1:8

I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

Mark 4:8

And other fell on good ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred.

Mark 4:34

But without a parable spake he not unto them: and when they were alone, he expounded all things to his disciples.

Mark 6:10

And he said unto them, In what place soever ye enter into an house, there abide till ye depart from that place.

Mark 10:26

And they were astonished out of measure, saying among themselves, Who then can be saved?

Mark 10:46

Author's Notes

When I was in high school, I thought that I wanted to be a writer. I was told I could never be a writer because of my poor handwriting; it was worse than it is now and I had a fear of failure. My handwriting only improved a little; it became more legible but not enough for some people to read. My desire to write became stronger despite the opinion of others, and being very fearful that I would not succeed. When I graduated high school in '85, I still believed I would become a writer, but did not focus on it.

After I moved to Florida in '88 from Michigan, I finally started writing a book. I only told a few people whom I did not know very well that I was writing. None of them discouraged me; some of them said I could if I really wanted to do it. I quit writing my book after a year and a half because I could not get my book to make sense and I feared it would be rejected so I just worked at a job.

I started my next book in '90. I only wrote one page and stopped again. I thought I would want to wait until I was married and had more time to write so I put it off.

Then in '93 I began writing word puzzles. I wrote 8 pages with 2 puzzles per page. I did 3 pages of crosswords and word searches and two of word scrambles. I saved all my work in hopes I could do something with it later.

For 6 years I put off doing anything with it. My handwriting was just so bad to ever be a writer. I could not get myself to improve enough to do it or overcome my fear of failing. I did realize years later that if my books were typed, no one would know how messy my handwriting really is - except for my autograph when doing book signings. Despite my hand writing my ideas are interesting, which is more important when writing.

In '99 I prayed several times to God to know what I should do with my life. God's answer was to finish the puzzle books I started. I would reply, "No, I can't write books that can't be what I was meant to do." I would pray for another answer. The vision of what I was meant to do was to write books starting with the word puzzles I had wrote down. At first I kept saying my writing is so very sloppy that I thought

it would not do good, God's answers stayed the same so I found the papers a few weeks later and I started to finish the books. When I got it to look like I wanted it to be, God said in the vision to finish it His way. I did not want to rewrite it, but was convinced to do the book again differently by separating the three kinds of puzzles into just one puzzle at a time starting with the word scramble alone rather than all together. God again said to do it His way; I did not want to revise the book again, but was convinced it would sell better if I did it. I rewrote it with the definition of the word with the verse and word.

When I had doubts during the writing, God would just say keep going and I would, and then after finishing it I looked for a publisher. I was led to someone who would publish it and we got it into print so I could sell my books.

I created this book by computer and published it with the help of a private publisher who helped me make it look more professional. The private publisher uses magazines with advertisements paid by sponsors, and does not need high volume magazine sales to earn money. My first publisher was unable to code books with a Library of Congress or ISBN so that the books may be sold in most bookstores. After it was in print I revised the word scramble again to have the definition closer to the meaning of each word in the Bible. After the next printing, a friend I have known for a long time helped the book look even better and we worked together to make the definition of each word even closer or right on to what it means in each verse. I started with a word and verse and went to a question of the word and verse..

My books are Bible study motivators – fun, interesting, challenging, educational, and self-benefiting. In the process of writing the books, I read the Bible and studied more for understanding of how words are used in verses, and how different words were used in the Biblical terms. I really do love and enjoy writing. It has given me more confidence in life.

I have sold more than 500 of my first book in just over a year. With my second puzzle book word search I have written, I've sold an additional 50 books in a year, My first book was priced very low at first, only \$2.00 tax included. Each book was 32 pages, including 26 pages with letters from A to Z.

While writing the word scramble I started writing children's books. I finished my word scramble and got it into print as my first book. While writing the word search I started writing novels, I did the word search and got it in print as my second book. I traveled and found an illustrator for my children's book and got Counting with Animals self-published for my third book. While I was making the word search better I got the word scramble actually self-published with a ISBN and bar code and made it look even better. Later I started to write lyrics to songs for a songbook while writing the crossword puzzle. My song lyrics still needed editing and notes. I wasn't sure that I knew how I wanted the songs melody to sound. I do intend to write other books. I have finished the writing part of 6 children books before I got the main publisher, only needed editing and pictures I am no artist, so that could take awhile. I have taken a long time to be able to get my novels finished.

After I got my first book published with a ISBN and bar code was in print, I wanted to travel for selling my books. Within a year that my first book was in print, I made reservations to travel to promote my writings. I started with bookstores in my hometown of Ocala.

Most of my book sales were by word-of-mouth, door-to-door, and through consignment bookstores. I have traveled to sell books and really want to travel for book signings. I have sold a few books through consignments in bookstores. The first bookstore that accepted my book only sold a few every year, but is still selling books. The second bookstore sold two to five copies a month until it went out of business just over a year later.

The month my word scramble was self published I went with my parents over 500 to Key West and got my books in a bookstore there 3/2004. In April I traveled north with my editor Charles A. Schuman to Georgia as far Macon over 300 miles, and got in a bookstore there. The same month I went to Orlando around 100 miles away with my editor Charles A. Schuman and I got in a bookstore there.

I went with editor C.A.S. and got my books in a few stores in Volusia in May, less than 100 miles away. I went alone and got in bookstores in Alachua, next county north of Marion in August.


I lost my home from the hurricane Jeanne in 9/04. I still did two radio interviews 11/2004 and 12/04. In a radio interview about my

first book, callers were challenged to solve a few of the puzzles from the book – winners were given a free copy of my book. I got in another store in Marion 12/04. I have tried many other stores and they would not take the books because they only take books from main publisher or distributors, and a few didn't take that kind of books.

I got books in a store in Kissimmee over 100 miles away in 2/2005, and then went with C.A.S. to Titusville over 200 miles in 3/2005. I did my first book signing in bookstore Marion County in 3/05. I got a new home in April the month of my Birthday. I traveled in 6/05 got in another store in Volusia. I went to Michigan with my Parents in July of 05 and got books in a store there the same city I was born Charlotte in Eaton County MI.

I improved my first book again for another printing and got my second book published with a ISBN in 12/05. I did my second book signing in Volusia in 12/05.

The next month and year I spoke on the Radio for another interview when I found out my books were advertise with online bookstores in 1/06. I have gotten into more bookstores by consignment and some bookstores paid me for the books. Now I only get into stores that pay for the books. I have done more and will do more book signings and radio interviews I started to work on doing interviews for the local newspaper and magazines, and do TV interviews. God Bless all of you.
